POSITION SUMMARY

Nominations are being called for Australian Indoor Cricket Physiotherapists / Sports Trainers to tour with Australian teams competing in the 2017 Masters Trans-Tasman Series.

Australian Indoor Cricket Physiotherapists / Sports Trainers are responsible for player physical wellbeing in the lead up and throughout the duration of the tour. They will be responsible for managing the recovery and rehabilitation programs for players in consultation with the Head Coach both during and prior to the tour.

Australian Indoor Cricket Physiotherapists / Sports Trainers are responsible to the Cricket Australia – Indoor Cricket Manager.

This position is an honorary role, with Cricket Australia funding event flights, accommodation, hire car, relevant apparel and daily allowance whilst on tour.

EXPERIENCE & REQUIREMENTS

- Demonstrated experience in applying knowledge of exercise science to deliver strength, conditioning, rehabilitation and recovery programs
- Minimum of an SMA Level 2 Accredited Sports Trainer or a qualified Physiotherapist with the APA
- Current Working with Children Check (or State/Territory equivalent)
- Applicants must be available for travel from October 15 – October 22 (any changes to travel dates will be circulated as known)
- Current First Aid certificate

KEY SKILLS

- Demonstrate ability to autonomously deliver a prehab and rehab program
- Demonstrate ability to work well within a team and to build good working relationships with other staff
- Proficient and effective communication and interpersonal skills



- Ensure a high level of consideration is given to the physical wellbeing of the playing group
- Open ability to giving and receiving feedback with players and staff

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Develop and implement a game day preparation program (warm up, cool down, recovery) in consultation with the Head Coach
- Oversee players' injury prevention, recovery and rehabilitation throughout the duration of the tour
- Be proactive in providing player health & wellbeing updates to the Head Coach
