Dear All,

Following the World Indoor Cricket Federation (WICF) meeting held in Dubai, the tournament dates and locations for the next two International events have been confirmed.

The 2018 WICF Junior World Series will be held in Christchurch, New Zealand from 29th September – 6th October 2018.

The 2019 WICF Masters World Series will be held in South Africa (location TBC), from 19th – 26th October 2019.

As per previous years, the 2018 Cricket Australia National Championship age requirements will fall in line with International competition dates.

At a National level, we are pleased to be able to introduce a new 30 & Over Women's division at the 2018 Australian Masters Championships.

A summary of all the divisions has been provided below along with the qualification for other Championship events and divisions.

Australian Masters Championships	
Saturday 26th May – Saturday 2nd June	
30 & Over Women	Players must be 30 years of age or over as of the first day of the Championships - Saturday 26th May
35 & Over Men	Players must be 35 years of age or over as of the first day of the Championships - Saturday 26th May
40 & Over Men	Players must be 40 years of age or over as of the first day of the Championships - Saturday 26th May
45 & Over Men	Players must be 45 years of age or over as of the first day of the Championships - Saturday 26th May
50 & Over Men	Players must be 50 years of age or over as of the first day of the Championships - Saturday 26th May

NB: There will be no International events for Masters players in 2018, with the Trans-Tasman being held in 2017.

Indoor Cricket National Championships	
Saturday 30th June - Saturday 14th July	
13 & Under Boys	Players must be 13 years of age or younger as of the last day of the 2018 WICF Junior World Series - Saturday 6 th October
14 & Under Girls	Players must be 14 years of age or younger as of the last day of the Indoor Cricket National Championships - Saturday 14th July
15 & Under Boys	Players must be 15 years of age or younger as of the last day of the 2018 WICF Junior World Series - Saturday 6th October
17 & Under Boys	Players must be 17 years of age or younger as of the last day of the 2018 WICF Junior World Series - Saturday 6th October
17 & Under Girls	Players must be 17 years of age or younger as of the last day of the 2018 WICF Junior World Series - Saturday 6th October
21 & Under Men	Players must be 21 years of age or younger as of the last day of the Indoor Cricket National Championships (Opens Division) - Saturday 7 th July
21 & under Women	Players must be 21 years of age or younger as of the last day of the Indoor Cricket National Championships (Opens Division) - Saturday 7 th July
Open Men	NA
Open Women	NA

NB: With no International competition for the 14 & Under girls division, the age qualification will remain as per the National Championship dates.
