Subject: 2017 Australian Indoor National Championships Age Criteria

Dear All,

Following on from the recent World Indoor Cricket Federation (WICF) Meeting that was held at the Masters World Series in Birmingham last week, the age requirements for the three upcoming International Series have now been confirmed. As a result, the Australian Indoor Cricket National Championships will fall in line with any International competition being played in that year, to ensure consistency across the competitions.

Please find the below summary of the age qualification for the 2017 Australian Indoor Cricket National Championships.

Australian Indoor Masters Championships	
Saturday 20th May - Saturday 27th May 2017	
35 & Over Women	Players must be 35 years of age or over as of the first day of the 2017 Trans-Tasman Series – Wednesday 18 th October 2017
35 & Over Men	Players must be 35 years of age or over as of the first day of the 2017 Trans-Tasman Series – Wednesday 18th October 2017
40 & Over Men	Players must be 40 years of age or over as of the first day of the 2017 Trans-Tasman Series – Wednesday 18th October 2017
45 & Over Men	Players must be 45 years of age or over as of the first day of the 2017 Trans-Tasman Series – Wednesday 18th October 2017
50 & Over Men	Players must be 50 years of age or over as of the first day of the 2017 Trans-Tasman Series – Wednesday 18th October 2017

* The National Championships criteria will reflect qualification for the International Trans-Tasman Series with some players therefore being 'underage' at the National Championships. eg: A player may be 34 at the National Championships, and turn 35 prior to the beginning of the International Trans-Tasman Series.

13 & Under Boys	Players must be 13 years of age or under as of the last day of the Championships - Saturday 8th July 2017
14 & Under Girls	Players must be 14 years of age or under as of the last day of the Championships - Saturday 8th July 2017
15 & Under Boys	Players must be 15 years of age or under as of the last day of the Championships - Saturday 8th July 2017
17 & Under Boys	Players must be 17 years of age or under as of the last day of the Championships - Saturday 8th July 2017
17 & Under Girls	Players must be 17 years of age or under as of the last day of the Championships - Saturday 8th July 2017
21 & Under Men	Players must be 21 years of age or under as of the last day of the 2017 WICF World Cup - Saturday 23rd September 2017
21 & Under Women	Players must be 21 years of age or under as of the last day of the 2017 WICF World Cup - Saturday 23rd September 2017
Open Men	NA
Open Women	NA

* The National Championships criteria reflects the WICF age qualification for the 2017 World Cup which will take place from Saturday 16th – 23rd September, 2017.
